# Camp Leader

## **Job Description:**

Camp Leaders will confidently and enthusiastically deliver camp programs to children ages 5-12 in the Lake Echo area. They will attend an orientation/ training week prior to summer camp starting to form a cohesive team, develop their leadership skills, learn behavior management strategies and to prepare for camp activities.

The Camp Leader position requires strong leadership skills, teamwork, a caring nature, and a willingness to have fun! Camp Leaders are directly responsible for camper supervision and safety as well as for facilitating a variety of age- appropriate activities.

## **Responsibilities**

- Camper supervision
- Assisting with child drop-off/ safe return back to parents/guardians
- Program planning
- Facilitating a variety of camp activities in an age-appropriate manner
- Ensuring participant safety during activities and at the lake (swimming time)
- Supporting children with diverse needs / creating an inclusive environment
- Communicating in an effective, professional and courteous manner with participants and their Parents/ Guardians
- Maintaining camp equipment and supplies
- Modelling positive behaviours' such as sportsmanship, manners, responsibility, flexibility, and respectfulness to camp participants
- Ensuring participant's needs are being met (in collaboration with the Child Specialist)
- Maintaining appropriate records as required including attendance and incident reports
- Participating in program evaluations and staff meetings
- Light cleaning
